Chile-Sweden Fund Seminary

Waste Energy Recovery. Sweden, a Sustainable Experience.

The seminar, **“Waste Energy Recovery, Sweden a Sustainable Experience”** took place on October 22, 2008 at the Hyatt Hotel in Santiago, Chile. This event was organized by the URBASER-KIASA Group and sponsored by the Swedish embassy and the Chile-Sweden Cooperation Fund.

The seminar gathered more than 120 assistants among ambassadors, mayors, ministerial regional secretaries, researchers, companies, and institutes linked to the environmental cause. A special guest, Chile’s Minister of Energy Marcelo Tokman made a presentation on **“Energy Challenges and Renewable Energy in Chile”**.

Additionally, the audience could find out about the work being developed between Chile and Sweden to identify able applications to appropriately manage waste in Chile. Moreover, the seminar showed finance alternatives for institutions in order to satisfy these projects, such as the Chile-Sweden Cooperation Fund.

At the event, researchers from the Swedish Environment Institute (IVL) and the Borlänge Energi Company made interesting presentations on the role of the government on environmental subjects. They also talked about sludge energy recovery and the use of waste incineration techniques as an alternative source of energy.
