Maricunga Mining Contract

Starting on December 2009, KDM manages the liquid, solid residues, and recycling services of this mining company. In addition, we supply chemical latrines.

We maintain, operate, and extract the mud from the waste water plant as well. Last, we are operating and managing the waste dumps and production excess yards.

Collahuasi Mining Contract

On March 1st, 2010, KDM started a new contract with this important company. The service consists on preventive and contingency industrial cleaning of a concentration plant. For this purpose, we will use the latest technologies and heavy machinery such as front loaders, back excavators, mini loaders, and a high vacuum cleaner.

Industrial cleaning in this contract is defined as the recovery of the mineral that permanently falls from conveyor belts, crushers, and the concentration systems. At the same time, we take care of major spills produced by system breakdowns and return the mineral back to the production line.

The courses were divided into two modules. The first one of 40 hours was focused on productive initiatives and the second one of 20 hours concentrated on environmental education.
