# KDM was present at

## Environmental Fair

Ambiental 2009, the VII Environmental meeting for Latin American took place at the Mapocho Station (Santiago) grounds between the 7th and 10th of October.



The environmental fair was organized by the Businesses and Professionals for the Environment Association (AEPA in Spanish) and the International Fair of Santiago (FISA) organization.

The conference called "From the fourth to the fifth Report of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change" (IPCC) opened the fair and was presented by Dr. Vicente Barros, an IPCC member himself.

Presiding over the inauguration were Fernando León, KDM general manager and vice president of AEPA; Alvaro Sapag, executive director of the National Environmental Commission (Conama in Spanish), and Paul Griffiths, AEPA president.



This is considered the most important environmental meeting in Latin America. It brings together outstanding professionals and businesses offering technological goods and services for areas such as energy, hydro resources, management and treatment for solid and liquid waste, emissions controls, and air quality among others.

KDM presented a large 40 sq. meter booth staffed with professionals who answered a deal of questions from visitors attending the fair. In addition, our team presented conferences and discussions where we were able to let the audiences know about our work in the energy, waste, and service fields.

## Til Til Expo



This fair has the purpose of showing and supporting the work of small entrepreneurs of Til Til county. The event was attended by municipal, regional, entrepreneurial authorities, and neighborhood leaders. The exposition took place between the 9th and 11th of October and once again was located around the Til Til main square grounds. One hundred and twenty expositors showed their very unique products, such as: olive paste, homemade liquors, local handcraft, hand-made weaves, and Chilean food products.



Fernando León, KDM general manager attended the fair inauguration and together with the rest of the authorities visited a number of exhibitors and recognized the great progress the community has made. Til Til has achieved much advancement in the past year and projects itself as a model town for the future.

Til Til expo was organized by the Pro-Til Til Development Business Association of which, KDM is an active member along with the municipality of Til Til and the Chacabuco Governor's Bureau.

Fernando León, our general manager was interviewed for the October's special issue of EcoAmérica. The publication covers environmentally sustainable businesses. The note was basically aimed to inform about KDM's leap into the energy realm. This new step opens our company to a whole world of future possibilities.

Two new internal combustion engines provided with electrical generators were installed at the Loma Los Colorados sanitary landfill. The motors will generate 2 megawatts (MW) that will be delivered to the Til Til electric company. The special feature of this operation is the fuel used by the engines; biogas extracted from the decomposition of organic waste in the sanitary landfill.



The project is being developed by KDM's Energy and Service Department and it is part of an even more ambitious initiative. This month starts a new public bidding process for a 14 MW electric plant to be built in 2010 and to begin service in the early months of 2011. The generation of power should be increased in 1 MW per year until reaching a final capacity of 28 MW in 2024. This power plant would take advantage of the methane generated in our landfill.
